## SAHARA Internship Program


SAHARA — Sustainable and Holistic Approach of Rejuvenation for All — is a year-long immersive internship beyond conventional learning.

# Who We Are Looking For?

Youthful, energetic, inquisitive, and creative individuals with a deep curiosity to learn, question, and engage meaningfully with life, nature, and society.

- Generally between 20 35 years of age (flexible for exceptional alignment).
- An appropriate graduation degree completed on or before January 1, 2026.
- Basic familiarity with computers and common office tools.
- Physical readiness for active, outdoor, and hands-on work.
- Willingness to commit fully to a one-year, immersive residential journey.







Monthly cost for food and accommodation: ₹30,000. The program carries no additional fee and does not offer a stipend.

- Applications close: 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2026
- Final Selection announcement: 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2026
- Internship begins: 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2026 Candidates with prior commitments may be allowed to start at a later date, if duly informed.



## **Process of Selection**

Stage 1 – Application

- Submit the application form.
- Application fee: ₹1500 (fully refundable upon admission).

Stage 2 – Interviews

 Candidates shortlisted from Stage 1 will go through a two-stage online interview.
On passing these, their place in the internship will be confirmed.





## **Program Cohort**


